*"And also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak."
Ephesians 6:19-20*

Crisis: An emotionally significant event that radically changes our lives; a turning point for better or for worse.

The greater the crisis, the greater the opportunity for the Church to pour the redemption of Christ into the wounds of humanity. **Days of crisis are days of unprecedented opportunity.**

PRINCIPLE 1: Churches that thrive in crisis see things other people don't see—they see the reality of heavenly places and discern the hidden causes behind the visible effects.

PRINCIPLE 2: Churches that thrive in crisis have a battle ready mindset.

PRINCIPLE 3: Churches that thrive in crisis walk in Christ's authority and function out of His ability.

PRINCIPLE 4: Churches that thrive in crisis pray prayers that only God can answer; they shift from self-reliance to Holy Spirit-reliance.

PRINCIPLE 5: Churches that thrive in crisis fulfill a ministry they never knew possible. They join Christ in gathering the harvest of the final unreached people on earth, gathering their neighbors, and gathering the nations.

A kingdom leader never loses sight of the goal line—the reaching of the final unreached people on earth.

A crisis changes the spiritual atmosphere faster than anything and causes people to recognize their own mortality.

The Apostle Paul is asking for prayer as an evangelist and church planter for two things:

1. For courage - *"That I may declare it boldly."*
2. For clarity - *"That words may be given to me...to proclaim the mystery of the Gospel."*
