Seek the Kingdom

"Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." Matthew 6:33

- » It is impossible to have a secondhand knowledge of the Kingdom.
- » Everything in the Kingdom is Holy Spirit activated, Holy Spirit revealed, Holy Spirit imparted and Holy Spirit advanced.
"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit." Romans 14:17
- » The key to operating in the Kingdom is to be consistently filled, controlled and activated by the Holy Spirit.
- » Everything God intends to do through you, He must first do in you. This is the fullness-fulfillment principle.

Learning to Recognize the Kingdom

1. Genuine humility
"Blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:3
2. Deep repentance
"The kingdom of God near. Repent and believe the good news!" Mark 1:15
3. People concertedly seek God.
"From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of God has been forcefully advancing, and forceful men lay hold of it ." Matthew 11:12
4. New steps of obedience
"[The wicked] will not inherit the kingdom of God." 1 Corinthians 6:9-10
"You will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering." 2 Thes. 1:5b
5. Deliverance from demons
"But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you." Matthew 12:28
6. Holy Spirit moving in lives
"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit." Romans 14:17
7. True signs and wonders
"For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power." 1 Corinthians 4:20
8. People get saved.
"I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." John 3:3
9. People falling deeper in love with Jesus.
"The kingdom of heaven is like a net that was let down into the lake and caught all kinds of fish." Matthew 13:47
"The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls." Matthew 13:45
10. Martyrs who die for Christ
"I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and patient endurance that are ours in Jesus" Revelation 1:9
"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:10
