



10 Marks of a Kingdom Leader

"From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been forcefully advancing, and forceful men lay hold of it." Matthew 11:12

1. We walk under the authority of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in full submission to our God-appointed authorities.

"For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard this, he was astonished and said to those following him, "I tell you the truth, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith." Matthew 8:9-10

"And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy." Colossians 1:18 2.

2. We walk in moral purity with a broken, contrite, and clean heart. Zero tolerance of pornography!

"Flee the evil desires of youth, and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart." 2 Timothy 2:22

"The wicked man flees though no one pursues, but the righteous are as bold as a lion." Proverbs 28:1.

3. We are overcomers who are delivered and free from any unauthorized control and from demonic strongholds.

"For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves." Colossians 1:13

"Deliver us from the evil one." Matthew 6:13 4.

4. We are listeners who have ears to hear what the Holy Spirit is saying.

"Speak, Lord, your servant is listening." 1 Samuel 3:9

5. We are radically obedient to the Word of God.

9. We are people of faith who live beyond the normal limitations.

10. We are pioneers who build and establish according to Kingdom principles.
