Kingdom journaling records only two things—where God is working and what God is saying. A journal is not a timeline of activities.

1. **Kingdom journaling prompts praise.**
"Continue steadfast in prayer, being watchful and thankful." Colossians 4:2
2. **Kingdom journaling prepares us to hear God's voice.**
*"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
Revelation 2:7,11,17,29; 3:6,13,22*
3. **Kingdom journaling increases faith.**
"Faith comes from hearing and hearing through the Word of Christ." Romans 10:17
4. **Kingdom journaling encourages new steps of obedience.**
"The Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him." Acts 5:32
5. **Kingdom journaling develops kingdom eyes.**
"To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 13:11, Luke 8:10
6. **Kingdom journaling enables us to be led by the Holy Spirit.**
"All who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God." Romans 8:14
7. **Kingdom journaling cultivates a grateful heart.**
"And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." Colossians 3:17
8. **Kingdom journaling makes it possible for you to linger in the seventh room of the Lord's Prayer Pattern.**
