The 3 R's to Overcome Discouragement

1. Recognize it.

"If we confess our sins He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

2. Refuse it.

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us." Hebrews 12:1

3. Replace it.

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." Romans 15:13
