5 Miracles of the Upper Room

1. The Miracle of Gathering

(a group numbering about a hundred and twenty)." John 12-15

2. The Miracle of Praying

"They all joined together constantly in prayer." Acts 1:14

3. The Miracle of Receiving

"All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:4a

4. The Miracle of Ministering to the Presence

"We hear them declaring the wonders of God in our tongues!" Acts 2:11

5. The Miracle of Harvesting

"When the people heard this they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, 'Brothers, what shall we do?'" Acts 2:37 "Those who accepted his message were baptized and about three thousand were added to their number that day." Acts 2:41 "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." Acts 2:47b
