1. How God Speaks -- *by His Spirit*

"The Spirit Himself testifies" Romans 8:16

God speaks through many means -- the Bible, people, circumstances, prayer, and spiritual gifts -- but He always speaks by the Holy Spirit.

"The Holy Spirit said, 'set apart for me Barnabas and Saul.'" Acts 13:3

There is a categorical difference between revelation and projection as well as our intuition; projection starts with us and revelation starts with God. To confuse the two is a lethal mistake. We don't dare call our projection a word from God--this is the definition of a false prophet.

3. Who can hear Him -- *children of God*

God can speak to us at any time and He does, because He is an initiator and because He wants a relationship with us, but He speaks most often when we seek Him.
