1. Wisdom—descriptors from the text

2. Foresight—the NASA way. The goal is the moon and back to earth. What will it take in regard to steps to get there and back.

Instruction—character, depth of character, the revelation of your true capacity for ministry and life.

2. What is manifesting in your life reveals what is in your heart. God is squeezing you to heal you, and Satan is squeezing you so that you will give up.
